Welcome to the 2023 Louisiana WIC Conference!

Welcome WIC staff, public health partners, and conference attendees to the 2023 Louisiana WIC Conference! 2022 was another challenging, yet successful year for our state and our program. I would like to thank you for all of the hard work you have put in to ensure we continue to deliver the best experience possible to the women, infants, and children who rely on our program. Following two years of virtual conferences, we are happy to be able to return to an in-person conference format this year. We made great strides over this last year to improve our services, and are excited to have the opportunity to share updates and developments in WIC programming with professionals in Louisiana this year.

In the last year, we have navigated emergencies while also expanding services and enhancing technology to improve both the clinic and shopping experiences. We are extremely proud of all of your hard work to help maintain services during the Abbott Formula Recall. In response to the recall, Louisiana WIC was able to offer 89 alternate standard and exempt formulas in order to keep our infants healthy. To further support our families' feeding decisions during this crisis, we focused on expanding breastfeeding support throughout our state through the Breastfeeding Peer Counselor Program and the addition of the Pacify application for 24/7 lactation support. For the first time, we officially designated 10 of WIC clinics as Breastfeeding Friendly – Gold Status.

As clinic services began returning to normal, we piloted and launched the myWIC application to make clinic flow more efficient. So far, over 1,400 invites have been sent out with over 700 active users. To enhance shopping dignity for WIC families, the State Agency certified 153 vendors to accept WIC transactions at self-checkout terminals at Albertsons, Brookshires, Kroger, Winn Dixie, and Wal-Mart stores. These stores make up approximately 35% of the total of WIC vendors throughout the state.

As we reflect on the last year and look ahead to the future, we hope this conference is an opportunity for all of you to network, and continue to strengthen your knowledge and skillsets within the field about which we are all so passionate. We also hope this will be a time for all of us to come together and develop new ideas that will allow for more improvements in how we provide services for the women, infants, and children of Louisiana.

Enjoy the conference and I look forward to meeting you during our sessions this week.





Clinic staff should only refer to the baby line for NON-WIC related resources.

Clinic staff are the best option for helping myWIC users, not State Ageny staff. If clinic staff get stuck, please call the LAWIN help desk.




Conference Map
